ELIGIBILITY: Rebates are available to all The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") or United Illuminating (UI) residential electric service customers ("Customer"). **Qualifying Geothermal System ("System") must be installed by a licensed contractor in the service territory of the participating electric utility on or after January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.** Applicant understands that all funding for rebates under this program derives from the Energy Efficiency Fund which is managed, in part, by Participating Utilities and funded, in part, by their customers. Neither Participating Utility guarantees the availability of funding for this program and neither is responsible for any costs or damages incurred by applicant if funding for this program or the Energy Efficiency Fund is reduced or eliminated by the State of Connecticut, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority or other State of Connecticut action. Rebates are subject to funding availability and are subject to change at any time without notice.

APPLICATION OFFER: The 2021 Residential Geothermal Performance Rebate Final Application For Existing Homes program ("Program") covers eligible System(s) purchased and installed on or after January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. This Application along with required documentation must be postmarked by January 31, 2022. Funding for this rebate Program is limited to the period indicated or while funds last. The geothermal system capacity is the AHRI (American Heating and Refrigeration Institute) rated cooling tonnage. The rebate amount is up to \$750/ton for customers who heat with electric or natural gas and \$1500/ton for customers who heat with fuel oil or propane with a per customer rebate limit of \$15,000. PROOF OF PURCHASE: The following documentation must accompany each rebate Application: 1) an installation service invoice itemizing the purchased System indicating the System type, manufacturer/brand and model numbers, the installed address, the installers' name and address and the date of purchase, 2) a copy of a recent electric utility bill, 3) an AHRI certificate for the matched assembly.

EQUIPMENT: Eligible Systems are: closed loop water to water, water to air and direct expansion ground source heat pumps. They must be a matched assembly that is a model combination that is listed in the AHRI Directory of Certified Equipment at: ahridirectory.org. When multiple sections are installed simultaneously, a matched assembly shall include the air handler, furnace, coil or other component that is used to determine the rating according to ARI/ISO/ASHRAE 13256-1/2 or ARI 370 published current standards. Water and DX to Water Systems must meet the utility-derived efficiency goal comparison. System(s) must be ENERGY STAR® certified and meet 2021 efficiency requirements as listed at energystar.gov.
